



## **New Business Guide**

**Welcome to North Hampton's business community!** Most of the questions you have about town regulations and permits needed can be answered quickly with one trip to Town Offices.

**Step 1:** All signs need a permit from the Building Inspector. Even if you aren't ready for a sign and just have some initial questions, start here with the Building Inspector.

**Step 2:** Call ahead to make an appointment with the Building Inspector (see info below). While you get your sign permit you can discuss any other issues with him regarding town regulations and permits needed.

**Step 3:** If you need any approval from the Zoning Board or Planning Board, or if the Building Inspector isn't in the office when you stop in, see the Planning and Zoning Administrator who will answer your questions (see information below). However, he cannot issue permits.
